Kia ora and welcome back to school!

We've had a great start to the first term! Our initial focus has been on settling into new classrooms, getting to know each other and establishing routines; the children have responded beautifully. **Twenty** new children will start in Kōwhai this term, and we extend a warm welcome to all of them and their families.

The first 3 blocks of our day focus on literacy and mathematics. Other curriculum areas such as science, the social sciences, technology, the arts, and physical education are explicitly taught in the afternoon and also woven into Student-Led Learning times (Learning Through Play). In Year 0/1, children have approx 1.5 hours of Student-Led Learning time, and in Year 2 children have approx 1 hour per day.

Learning This Term:

<u>Mathematics:</u> Our first focus of the term is Statistics, which includes investigative questioning, data collection, data analysis, and sorting. The contexts for this learning will provide a fantastic opportunity for us to learn more about each other.

Literacy:

We aim to build strong foundations for reading and writing while in the first years. Teachers assess each child's knowledge and skills and then cater for individual needs in areas such as phonemic awareness, letter-to-sound knowledge, fluency, comprehension, handwriting, sentence structure, punctuation.

<u>Physical Education:</u> This term we will build gross motor skills through running, jumping, throwing, and catching games, all while promoting social skills like cooperation and communication. Each session is designed to boost confidence and physical development in a supportive and energetic environment, allowing the children to learn, grow, and enjoy the benefits of physical activity.
